Abbey Leffe Blonde, Belgium \$5

A dry, fruity, lightly spiced beer, full and creamy - a perfect balance of strength and subtlety. This blonde has a delicate and light, malty aroma and a subtle, sweet finish.

Weihenstephaner Vitus Weizenbock, Germany \$6

A light-colored, spicy single-bock wheat beer, for both beer lovers and the beer connoisseur. It is truly a special beer with full body and a distinctively great mouthfeel.

Messiah Bold, New York \$5

A deep, bold nut brown ale beautifully balanced with rich dark malts and a complex hop character converging to reveal a simply enchanting elixir.

Anchor Old Foghorn, California \$6

This beer has a pleasant hop bitterness, due to a large quantity of hops used during brewing and a unique hop aroma due to the dry-hopping and aging.

Blackthorn Cider, England \$5
