Champagne / Sparkling White Wine

1) Vollis Mareni NV Prosecco "Ombra", Brut-Veneto, Italy

This producer places high importance on the delicate floral aromas occurring in the character of the grapes, this coupled with gentle fizz makes this a delicious, refreshing sparkling wine.

White Wines

2) Xarmant Txakolina, Arabako, Spain (2007)

More acid than a Grateful Dead Concert! Stainless steel fermented with bright citrus flavors. This is a really fun wine.

3) Bodegas Aresan Airen, La Tierra de Castilla, Spain (2005)

Bright straw-yellow color. Flowery aromas on the nose, with intense pineapple and green apple notes. Well-structured, with body and class, ending with a persistent sweet finish.

4) Vina Meyor Verdejo, Rueda, Spain (2007)

100% Verdejo. A very unique wine. Citrus fruit notes of lemon, lime and light melon. The flavors are rich and offer a great partner for fish and lighter shellfish.

5) Piko, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand (2006)

The nose of this wine displays abundant aromas of ripe tropical fruit with hints of bell pepper, goose berries, and capsicum. The taste is fresh and lively, and full, show a rich concentration with a persistent finish.

6) Simonsig Chenin Blanc, Stellenbosch, South Africa (2007)

Beautifully expressive sweet fruit, aromas of green apples, ripe pears and floral notes. Layered complexity and smooth silky texture on the finish.

7) Louis Pato Maria Gomes, Bairrada, Portugal (2007)

Aromas of grapefruit, mineral, lemon, and pepper. This wine is light, very crisp with high acidity and surprising length. A great compliment to any seafood dish.

8) Alto Vista Torrantés, Salta, Argentina (2006)

Coming from what is considered to be the best place in the world to grow this varietal, this wine is bright yellow in color with delicate floral aromas. A premium Torrantés with excellent balance and vibrant acidity.

9) Gavi di Gavi Cortese, Alessandria, Italy (2006)

Made from the ancient Cortese varietal. This wine has an intense, persistent bouquet, with pale yellow and green highlights. The taste is elegant, slightly dry with a great finish.

10) Colombelle, Gasconne, France (2007)

A beautifully unique blend of Colombard and Ugni Blanc offer powerful flavors of citrus, mango, and pineapple. Vibrant and well-balanced.

Red Wines

11) Coopers Creek, Hawkes Bay, Pinot Noir, New Zealand (2006)

Aromas of red and black fruits with a touch of oak. Very Burgundian, true to form Pinot Noir. It is round and supple, with just enough body to give great overall structure. Masses of sweet fruit on the finish.

12) Zolo, Bonarda, Mendoza, Argentina (2005)

Argentina's most planted varietal. This wine highlights the grapes characteristically raspberry and strawberry jam aromas. Smooth with sweet, soft tannins, finishing with toasty barrel notes.

13) Massaya Classic Red, Lebanon (2006)

A beautiful blend of Cinsault, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Syrah. A strawberry hue with cherry highlights and a raspberry, summer fruit nose. It is light, round and very easy to drink.

14) Majus, Nero d'Avola, Sicily, Italy (2006)

Ruby red colour, intense and refined flavors. Round and well-balanced, with a generous after taste. This varietal has always been a Gruppo favorite, BRAVO!

15) Badia Al Colle Chianti, Tuscany, Italy (2006)

100% Sangiovese, this is an easy drinking wine with deep cherry flavors. Almond on the nose, core ripe fruit flavors and fine tannins with a very refreshing finish.

16) Buglioni, Valpolicella, Verona, Italy (2006)

Bright ruby red, fragrant, intense aroma of cherry and delicate berry fruit. Perfect with antipasta, pasta dishes, and a great seafood red wine.

17) Pedroncelli, Three Vineyards, Cabernet Sauvignon, Sonoma County, California (2006)

A wonderful Bordeaux blend of Cabernet, Cabernet Franc, and Merlot. This wine shows rich aromas of raspberry with cherry highlights. Plum and toasted oak combine to round out the flavors.

18) Chateau Grimard Bordeaux Rouge, Bordeaux, France (2006)

80% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon. A wine with definition and character. This wine is very versatile and food friendly. Great with chicken and light red sauce dishes.

19) Benson Ferry 95240, Lodi, California (2006)

Old Vine Zinfandel showcasing ripe, forward blackberry and raspberry flavors, accented by hints of cedar and chocolate. Smoothness and focus lead to a supple and lingering finish.

20) Valentin Bianchi Famiglia, Cabernet Sauvignon, Mendoza, Argentina (2006)

An ultra rich blend of Cabernet, Cabernet Franc, Petite Verdot, and Merlot. A complex nose reminiscent of berries, spice, cedar and chocolate. A very well-balanced wine with a lingering, pleasing finish.

21) Longview, "Red Bucket" Cabernet/Shiraz, Adelaide Hills, South Australia (2005)

Just named the best Shiraz in Australia! Dark red, spicy and berry aromas deliver great freshness. It's a must try for Shiraz lovers!

22) The Ruins, Robertson Valley, South Africa (2006)

Medium-to-full bodied wine that shows great complexity with its three varietal components. A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Shiraz and Merlot, this well-balanced wine is sure to please!

23) Vinas de Vila Malbec, Argentina (2005)

Rich, fruit driven and bright, this is a wine for hearty cold weather foods. A lovely berry, fruity nose, with a palate that will compliment all more hearty dishes.

24) Vina Tabali, Shiraz, Limari Valley, Chile (2006)

100% Shiraz that offers undertones of smokey bacon, oak, and sweetness. Dark fruits, with long length, great concentration and a superior finish.
