Champagne / Sparkling White Wine

- 1) **Bricco Riella Moscato D'Asti DOCG, Italy (2008)** \$8
This aperitif/dessert wine displays a fragrant bouquet and a delicately sweet-scented taste.
- 2) **Adami Prosecco, Italy** \$9/\$38
A citrus nose leads to amazingly creamy fine bubbles with hints of apple, pear, and melon. The perfect toast to begin any meal or celebrate any occasion, and sure to please anyone looking for a dry sparkling.

White Wines

- 3) **Domain Pinchot Vouvray, France** \$10/\$40
Generations of expertise explode on the hugely floral nose of this 100% Chenin Blanc. The region's chalky soil leaves a minerality that balances beautifully with the crisp acidity and tangerine citrus flavors. Just enough residual sugar in this wine to lend a delicate sweetness that will leave you craving another taste.
- 4) **Vermentino di Sardegna "Benas", Italy** \$10/\$40
Vermentino has emerged as Sardinia's star variety and we think for good reason! The 2008 offers a bright straw-yellow colour with heady scents of wild herbs and white blossom. An all-around beautifully aromatic wine! On the palate it is light and clean and finishes with a lovely soft spice.
- 5) **Stephano Chistiani Pino Grigio, Italy** \$10/\$40
Light green lustres run through the radiant straw yellow color of this wine, whose aroma is rich in fruits, the most striking of which are pears and apples.
- 6) **Fairhall Downs Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand** \$12/\$48
Clear and bright in appearance, this blend of citric and tropical flavors pairs well with seafood and wonderfully flavored cheeses.
- 7) **Tariquet Chenin Chardonnay** \$8/\$34
This wine marries the finesse of Chenin Blanc (75%) with the elegance and structure of Chardonnay (25%). This complex wine displays delicious floral notes, as well as exotic fruit and vanilla.
- 8) **Colterenzio Chardonnay, France** \$8/\$34
Delicate, floral aromas and flavor infused with hints of exotic fruits such as pineapple, and mango, a concentration of mellowness and vivacity on the palate with classic mineral notes and crisp acidity.

Red Wines

- 9) **Three Deans Pinot Noir, New Zealand** \$11/44
 The wine displays rich red berry, plum, earthy forest floor, and subtle oak aromas on the nose. The palate is full and rounded with a long persistent finish. Smooth, smooth, smooth!
- 10) **Domaine Cabirau Serge & Tony, France** \$9/38
 Aromas of red fruits and herbs lead to a softly textured wine with notes of tomato and bacon.
- 11) **Gini Chianti, Italy** \$7/30
 Light-medium bodied, with sour cherry and black fruit flavors, this wine shows very soft tannins and pleasant acidity. Modern, crisp, fruity, smooth, fresh, tasty wine.
- 12) **Rosso Toscano, Italy** \$8/34
 Excellent balance, soft but decisive taste, consistent bouquet with primary aroma of red fruits (cherries and black cherries) with a touch of vanilla flavors.
- 13) **Tamas Double Decker Red, California** \$8/34
 This blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Barbera and Petit Syrah is pleasantly vinous, delicate and fresh, fruity with hints of violets and roses.
- 14) **Sogno, DiStefano Winery, Washington** \$11/44
 Sogno means dream in Italian and the winemaker made this wine as a gift to his wife! Medium bodied with elegant but firm tannins and slightly toasted on the finish. Blend: 91% Cabernet Franc and 9% Cabernet Sauvignon.
- 15) **Silver Ridge Cabernet Sauvignon, California** \$7/30
 This wine is best described as elegant, rich, smooth, with black cherry, currant and toasty oak shadings. The finish is mild with polished tannins.
- 16) **Dona Paula Shiraz/Malbec, Argentina** \$10/\$42
 Aromas of dark chocolate, blackberry and plum flavors that are integrated with spice, mint and a hint of licorice. Concentrated palate with fine balance and harmony with a long finish.
- 17) **Iovine Aglianico, Italy** \$9/38
 From the shadows of Mount Vesuvius in Campania comes this wine made from the ancient Aglianico grape. Volcanic soil from centuries of eruptions lends a minerality unlike any other region in the world. This combined with the rich and spicy flavors of the grape leaves a true treat for those looking for a full bodied wine.
- 18) **Branham Jazz, California** \$13/52
 The Jazz quartet is fronted by Napa Valley Zinfandel (40%), Petite Sirah (20%), Syrah (20%), and Cabernet Sauvignon (20%). Our chops have matured with this vintage, and this mastery of composition begins with harmonious fruit on the nose, segues to refined melodies of black-plum, dark berries, and coffee notes on the palate, and brings down the house with a purposeful symmetry of tannins and acidity at the finish.
